REPORTS:

Tournament of Champions (Cheryl Newman): The 2012 Tournament was hosted by Country Hills and this year's winner was Joan Wilson of Country Hills. The 2013 Tournament will be hosted by River Spirit.

Medalist (Cheryl Inkpen): The 2012 windup is scheduled for October 22 at Pasquale's.

Riley's Match Play (Cindy Beaudet): The finals will be moving to the Calgary Golf & Country Club in 2014 due to a separation from the Men's Division. A discussion has begun regarding the sharing of the finals for this event in rotation by Canyon Meadows, Calgary Golf & Country Club, Earl Grey and Willow Park. All indexes should be those at time of Entry. Twenty percent of entries are problematic so registration forms will not be accepted unless completed correctly with all information for both players included. A proposal has been made to make the Cocktail Reception mandatory and a ruling made that will not allow substitutes. Also it was proposed that the Cocktail Reception be held within 2 weeks of the schedule starting date.

Five-Year Plan (Kim Carrington): There has been no work done on this plan as the AGA was focused on its 100th Anniversary celebrations this year. Kim is hoping to get it back on track with a plan taking us through 2017. A general discussion regarding the Plan followed.

Junior Girls Amateur (Monika Jansen/Kim Carrington): Recommendations were made to have the 9-holers play from the forward tees, continue one more year with the boys (discussions to be held with the CGA regarding support). The pendant needs to be ordered in a more timely fashion.

Senior Ladies Amateur (Sheila Wares): Complaints about course being too long, encountered problems regarding setting up flights based on indexes. A recommendation was made to divide flights by 12 people in each flight to lessen the number of count-backs. The value of the prizes for Low Net and Low Gross should be the same. One set of tee markers should be in place only. Kim

Carrington was asked to get a price on obtaining our own tee markers to be moved around to each Amateur. Discussion took place regarding the two cheating incidents, as well as the lack of pin sheets on the first day. Recommendations will be put in the next tournament binder. Debbie Cook is going to arrange for new banners for each Amateur.

Past President (Archives) (Marny Dabbs): All tournament info between 2002 and 2011 has been set up at the Glenbow Museum. Marny advised everyone to purge their own copies of Minutes, Agendas, etc. so that only one copy is kept at the Glenbow.

CHAMPS (Debbie Cook): The 2012 CHAMPS wind-up was held at Springbank Links Golf Club on Monday, September 24. 98 players participated and this year's winners were presented with their trophies/plaques. The winners are:

Publicity/Media (Debbie Cook): Debbie advised that the Amateur received good coverage from CTV (Glenn Campbell) and the Herald (John Down). However, the Juniors only received coverage by CTV (Glenn Campbell). Debbie held discussions with Gordon Smiley, Asst. Editor of Sports with the Calgary Herald who advised that John Down had left the Herald and they were struggling with coverage of local amateur sports. He asked her to send all results and tournament information to himself.

Cindy Beaudet inquired as to whether or not it was time to engage the assistance of a Public Relations firm regarding news coverage.

DISCUSSIONS:

Kim Carrington was asked to remove Mapleridge as hosting the 2014 Junior Girls Amateur from the 5-year Plan.

We will not be required to present a Resolution at the Fall AGM concerning the removal of the City courses from the CLGA as the matter has been resolved with the City. The City courses will be treated as one entity - that was the intention when they joined the CLGA. Debbie Cook will advise the Fall AGM that there will be one CHAMPS representative from the City courses.

Debbie will inquire as to whether River's Edge would like to join CHAMPS.

Cindy Beaudet will present a small gift to Louise Yont in appreciation for her assistance with the CHAMPS schedule over the past few years.

The CLGA will be submitting a cheque in the amount of \$2,000 to the AGA for the Junior Girls' Development Fund in honour of Diane Williams and Marilyn O'Connor. A discussion ensued about the financial subsidization of golfers attending Nationals, etc. The AGA has guidelines, which we need to see and approve. Final recipients of these awards will be announced after the CLGA has approved the final selections. The cheque for \$2,000 will be forwarded upon receipt of an invoice from Brent Ellenton of the AGA representing the CLGA's contributions for 2012 and 2013.
