New Business

(a) Introduction of Beads of Courage

A presentation was provided by Alberta Childrens' Hospital Beads of Courage Representatives Rae Parry, and Victoria Plouffe to outline the program and how the CLGA has partnered. A short video was shown and will be posted on the website.

Deb Cook provided an overview on how the CLGA will partner with the Beads of Courage program. The CLGA will purchase the Beads of Courage packages to present as tee gifts for participating players in the CLGA sanctioned tournaments, (Calgary Amateur, Calgary Senior Amateur, Calgary Junior Amateur).

(b) CLGA Organizational Structure/Hosting Responsibilities

A discussion paper was provided by Debbie Cook to all members of the CLGA regarding the challenges the organization is experiencing, particularly with the changing face of golf and the golf industry. Lengthy discussion followed. Points of Discussion:

-the CLGA executive structure has been unchanged in many years, and it is increasingly difficult finding volunteers for positions. Currently there is no member appointed to the "5 year plan" position. This position requires a significant time commitment, as well as building relationships with host club representatives for future tournament bookings.

-Many clubs are now asking for a "fee per participant" to cover revenue lost when hosting tournaments.

-CLGA assessment fee per female member has been \$1.00 since 2007. Should the CLGA increase the assessment fee and would the members get "value for their money" if the fees were increased.

-Of note, the CLGA has 4,708 members of which only 285 members who participated in tournaments

Deb is suggesting that a task force be set in place to review challenges and suggest possible solutions when partnering with prospective host clubs; looking at the feasibility of increasing the assessment fees per female member; and how to promote increased participation in tournaments.

All club members in attendance were encouraged to have open discussion with their female members with thoughts and ideas regarding promotion and participation of the CLGA.
